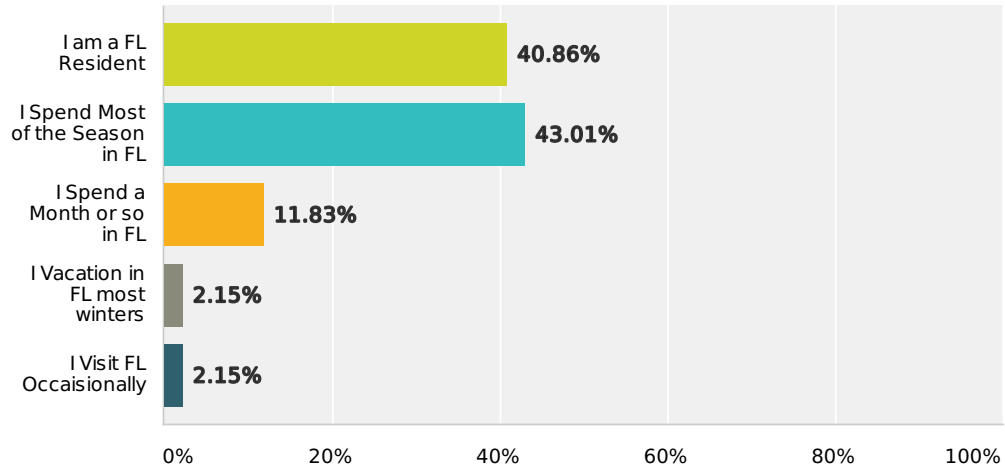


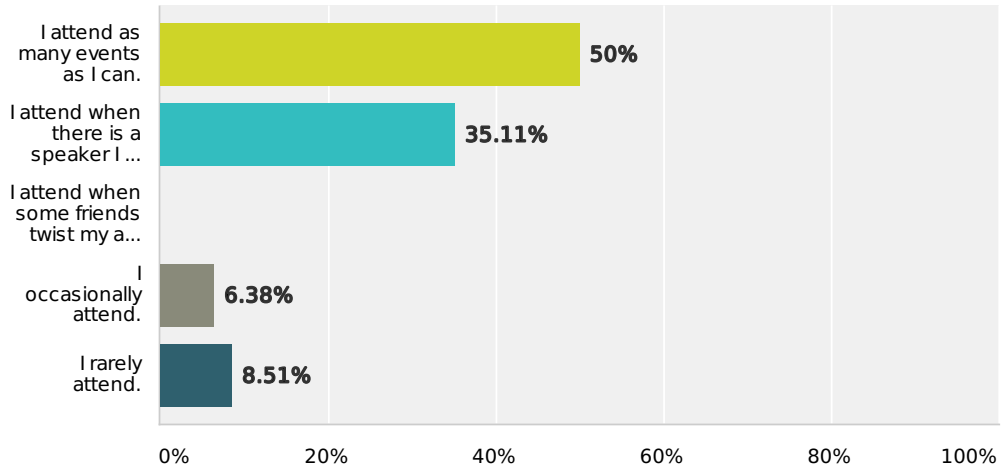
## Q1 How much time do you spend in SW Florida?

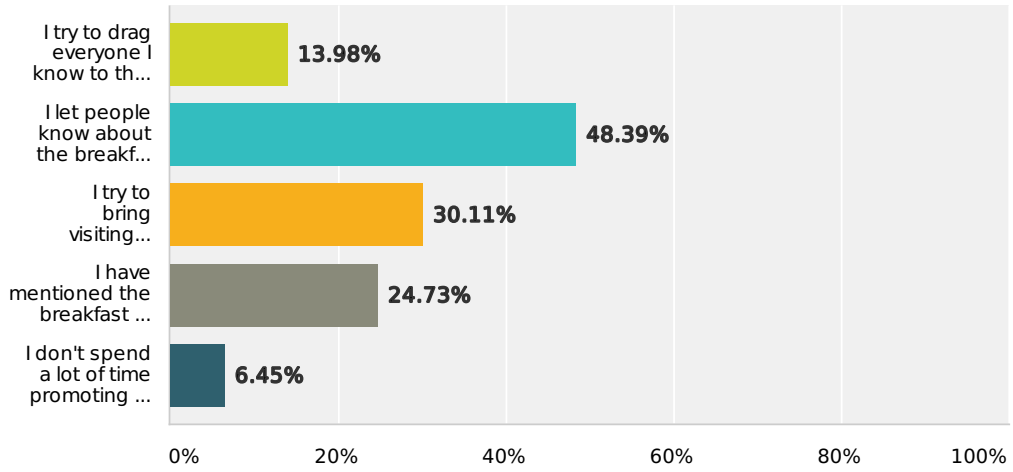
## Q2 How often do you attend the MN Men's Breakfast?

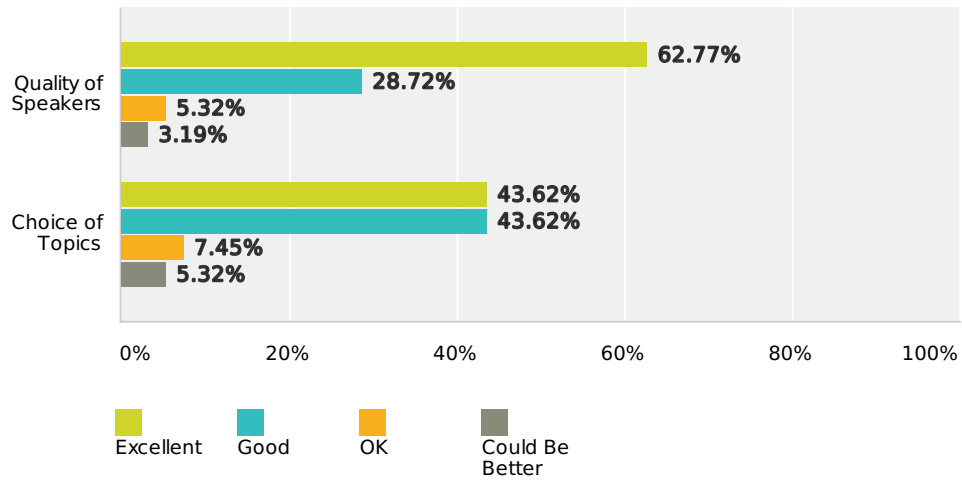
### Q3 Do you encourage friends to attend the MN Men's Breakfast? (check all that apply)

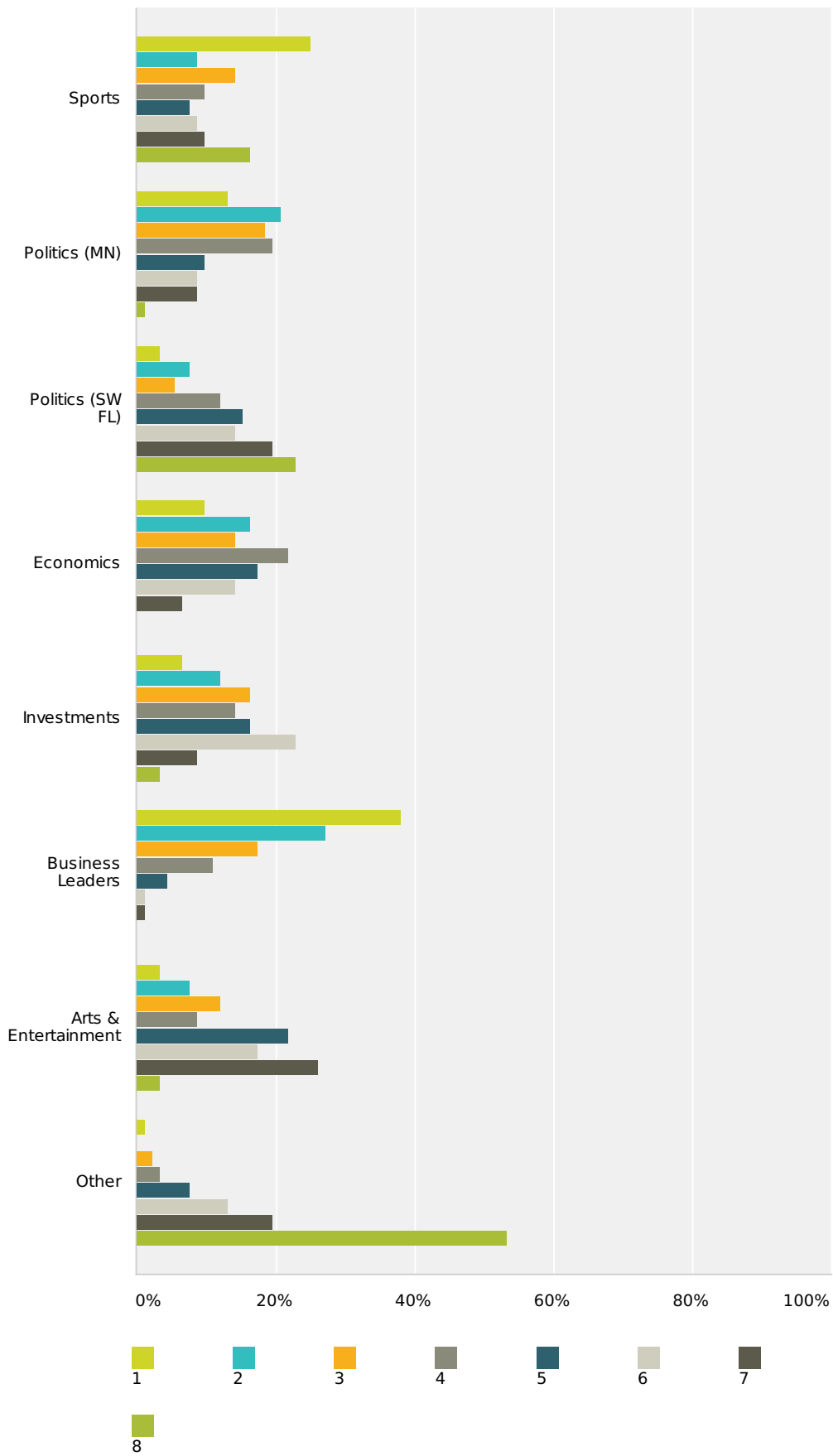
